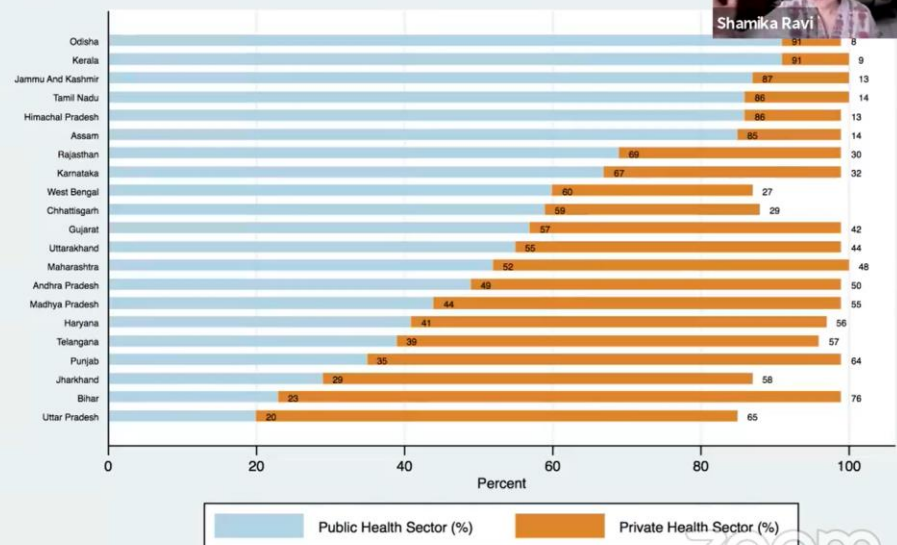

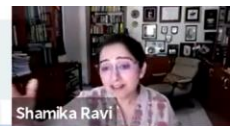


Health System

- **Activity Description** – The paper has considered that NEP 2020 identifies several strands of problems and institutional challenges in the higher education ecosystem in India, there is a common theme that covers all these problems and challenges and has recognized the systemic rigidity which prevails in both the intellectual and the administrative spheres and one can further categorize them under three broad heads. This paper focuses on the first two challenges and their ramifications for India's overall ability to produce skills. But the rigidities are inter-connected, and one feeds into the other. It further argues that administrators of India's formal educational institutions adopt an "Open Source" strategy in consonance with NEP 2020. It briefly describes India's Higher Education System; the magnitude of India's problem through a discussion on the emerging demand for skills and the skill gap in the economy; focuses on the program design needed to inculcate new skills and competencies in students to make them more employable; and lastly, discusses the underlying changes needed to support this program design in terms of curriculum development, pedagogical systems, faculty and infrastructure.

Post 1990s

- The course and functions of the state and public administration has changed since early 1990s with the adoption of liberal policies and programs aimed at more integration with the global world. The process of liberalization, privatization, and globalization (LPG) has set a new agenda for public administration in the country with the gradual shedding of many commercial activities by the government.
- The state, formerly an interventionist, producer, regulator, and seller, is now called upon to be a facilitator, promoter, and partner; the emergence of powerful technological solutions (e.g., computers and information technology) and increasing expectations from governments to “perform” are the realities of the current-day administration. The process of governance bundled together the political, social, and economic aspects, including formal and informal actors in decision making.
- Under the present government, the expectations are certainly sky high. Is civil service capable of delivering?

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Inclusiveness (Contd)

- In India constitution provided for the reservation for Scheduled Castes and Tribes, a policy which has been continued even after its initial period.
- There has been further extension of inclusiveness by providing for OBCs in the services at Centre and the states.
- In many states, reservation for women has also been attempted successfully.
- Further to remove elitisms from the services vernacular languages have been allowed not only in written but also in the interviews.
- All these augur well to mobilize the potential of all sections of society.

- In 2018, Chinese trade in the region peaked at US\$1.5 trillion, 5 x India's

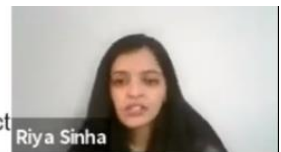

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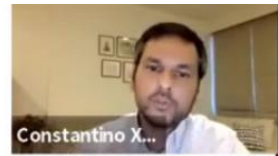
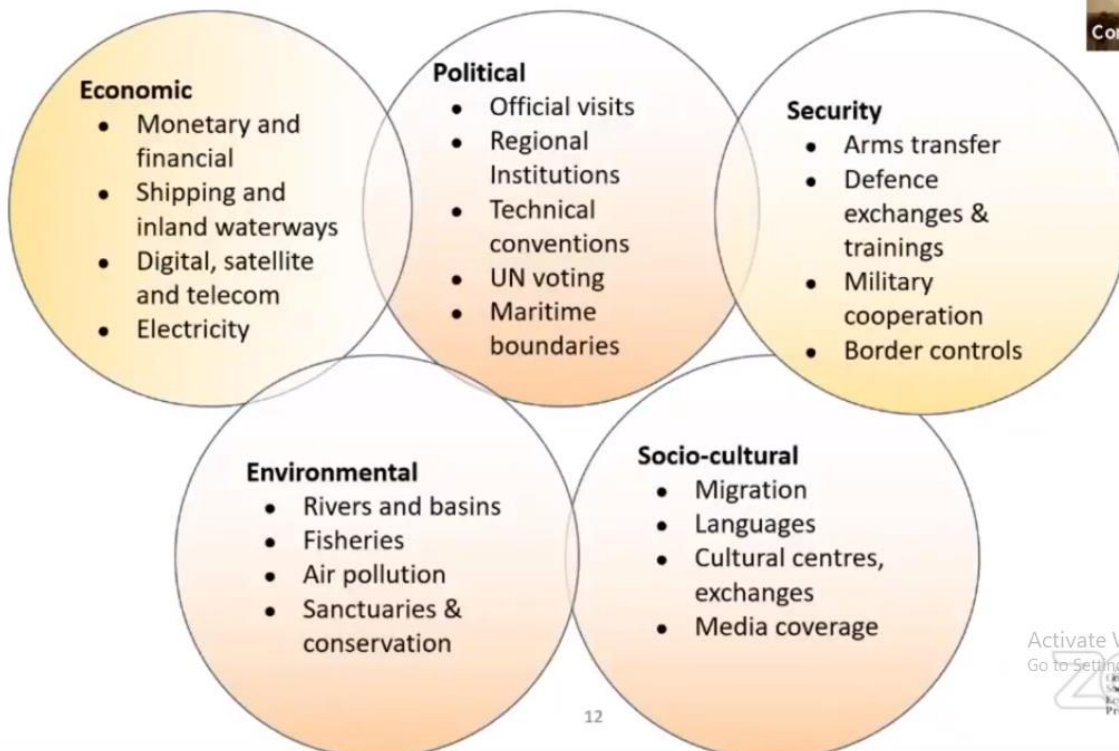


- However, the **Neighbourhood First** policy is a vict success: while more than ever is being done, there is an increasing demand and competition in the neighbourhood.

 - constructive engagement with the neighbouring countries.



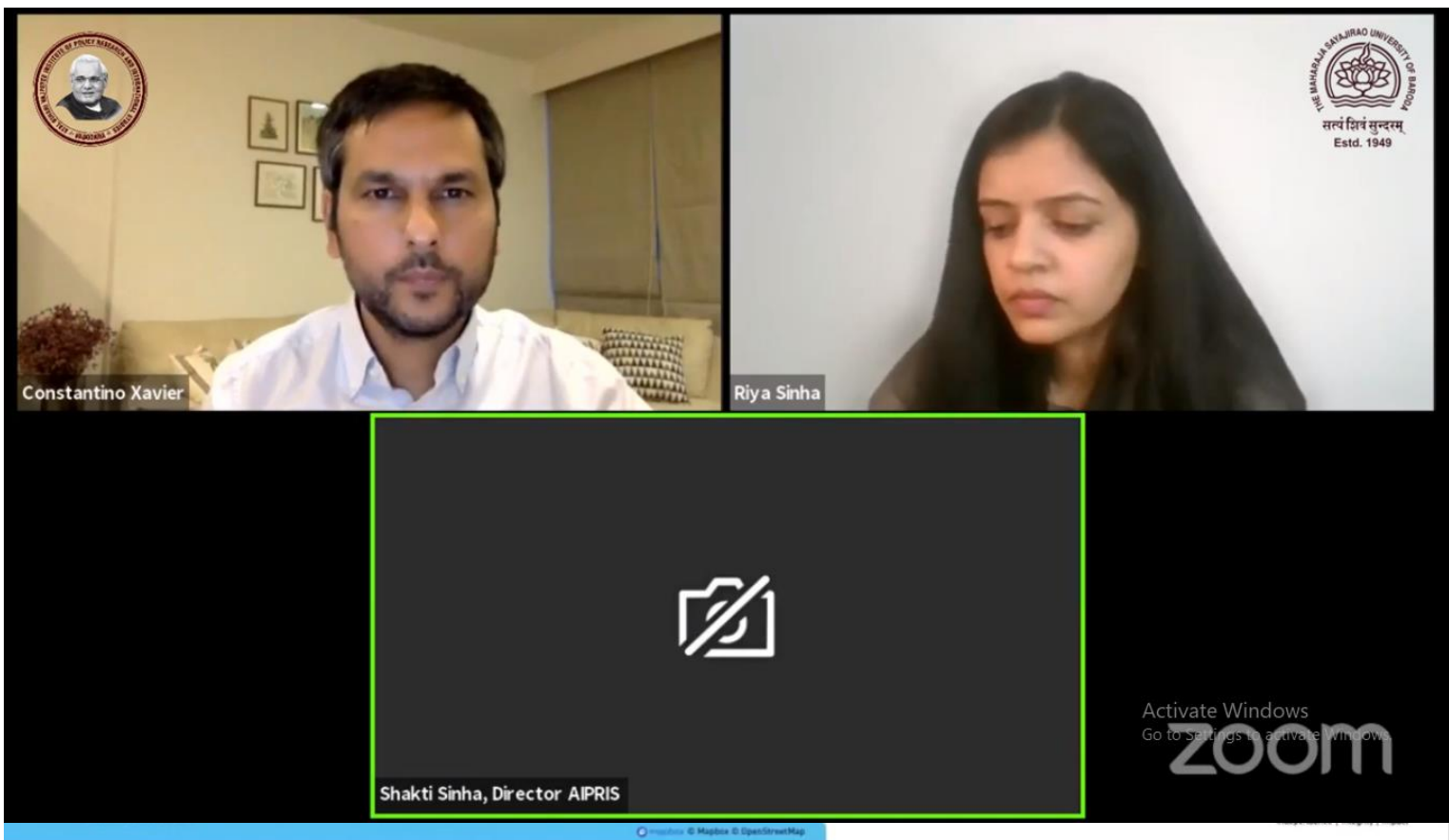
